Senator Mark DeSaulnier (Chair)-Democrat

Represents the 7th Senate District which includes: Antioch, Brentwood, Clayton, Concord, Danville, El Cerrito, Hercules, Lafayette, Martinez, Moraga, a portion of Richmond, Oakley, Orinda, Pinole, Pittsburg, Pleasant Hill, San Ramon, Walnut Creek.

Senator Ted Gaines (Vice Chair) - Republican

Represents the 1st District and is all or parts of: Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, El Dorado, Lassen, Modoc, Mono, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento and Sierra counties. It is a diverse district that also includes many of the Sacramento suburbs. Major cities within the district include: Roseville, Auburn, South Lake Tahoe, Truckee, Elk Grove, Rancho Cordova, Folsom, Placerville, El Dorado Hills, Jackson, San Andreas, Mammoth Lakes, Susanville, Quincy and Alturas.

Senator Tom Harman - Republican

Represents 35th Senate District which covers most of Orange County's coastline and includes the cities of Seal Beach, Huntington Beach, Fountain Valley, Costa Mesa, Newport Beach, Irvine, Cypress, La Palma, Los Alamitos, Laguna Beach, Dana Point, portions of Buena Park, Garden Grove, Santa Ana, and Westminster and the unincorporated areas of Rossmoor and Sunset Beach.

Senator Christine Kehoe - Democrat

Represents District 39 which is a beautiful area stretching east-west from Spring Valley to the Pacific Ocean, and north-south from Del Mar to Downtown San Diego. It encompasses 847,000 residents from Del Mar and Lemon Grove, and parts of San Diego, Casa de Oro-Mo, La Presa, and Spring Valley.

Senator Alan Lowenthal - Democrat

Represents District 27 which includes the communities of: Artesia, Avalon, Bellflower, Cerritos, Downey, Florence-Graham, Hawaiian Gardens, Lakewood, Long Beach, Lynwood, Paramount, Signal Hill, South Gate, and Willowbrook.

Senator Fran Pavley - Democrat

Represents the 23rd Senate District, which includes the cities of Agoura Hills, Beverly Hills, Calabasas, Hidden Hills, Malibu, Oxnard, Port Hueneme, Santa Monica, West Hollywood and Westlake Village, as well as several communities in the City of Los Angeles, including Bel Air, Beverly-Fairfax, Beverly Glen Canyon, Brentwood, Canoga Park, Century City, Chatsworth, Encino, Hollywood, Mt. Olympus, Northridge, Pacific Palisades, Sherman Oaks, Studio City, Tarzana, Topanga, West Los Angeles, West Hills, Westwood and Woodland Hills.

Senator Michael Rubio – Democrat

Represents all or portions of Fresno, Kern, Kings and Tulare Counties.

Senator Joe Simitian - Democrat

Represents Santa Clara, San Mateo and Santa Cruz -- and includes the following communities: San Carlos, Redwood City, Menlo Park, Atherton, East Palo Alto, Palo Alto, Stanford, Los Altos, Los Altos Hills, Cupertino, Campbell, Santa Cruz, Capitola, and a third of San Jose
